The Jefferson City Figure Skating Club is a Tax-Exempt organization under section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

What is the Jefferson City Figure Skating Club (JCFSC)?

The JCFSC is a non-profit organization whose purpose is to promote figure skating to all ages and abilities in the Central Missouri community.

JCFSC offers beginner, intermediate and advance classes. Skaters range from 3 years of age to adults. JCFSC also offers a special needs class for skaters with disabilities.

Throughout the skating season, JCFSC offers lessons and social events for its members. JCFSC members are also eligible to skate in the Annual Ice Show at the end of the skating season.

How are the donations used?

Donations are received from both individuals and corporations. The monies collected are then used to defray operating costs to keep our fees low for skaters in the community. These costs include ice time, coaching fees, costumes for shows, lessons, and off-ice classes.

What benefit does a sponsor receive?

JCFSC Sponsors are listed on our website for the season in which they are a sponsor. Our website averages over 9,000 hits a month! Sponsors with websites will also have a link to their site from ours.

Sponsors are also listed at the Washington Park Ice Arena which has daily public sessions, youth figure skating lessons, hockey clubs, and a speed skating club.

JCFSC also lists our sponsors in the Annual Ice Show program that is available to attendees all three nights of the show!
