I hope everyone is enjoying their summer and is excited to get back on the ice soon!

The rink re-opens on August 1, 2008 for the 2008-2009 operating season. We will have the pre-season camps again this season but we have added 2 more nights for a total of 6! These will run every Thursday from August 14<sup>th</sup> to September 18<sup>th</sup>.

Mark your calendars for registration night on September 25<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 to 8:00 pm with skating from 6:00 to 8:00. We have added another freestyle time to our schedule this season! We have eliminated the usage of the freestyle passes and families must now register for the freestyles in advance. Be sure to get familiar with the enclosed Freestyle Rules sheet that is enclosed. We are offering a credit to those who return their 2007-2008 Freestyle passes before or during registration night.

Also to complete registration with JCFSC, parents will need to sign a Parent Code of Conduct as well as the Insurance Waiver for minors. Skaters over the age of 18 will need to sign these documents as well, but may skip the part on the insurance waiver regarding "Parental Consent and Indemnification Agreement".

Parks & Recreation has set the ice show date for the upcoming season! The dates are April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> and the theme is "Continental Tours".

The Club has positions open on a variety of committees for the upcoming season. All JCFSC parents are encouraged to volunteer whatever time and talents you are able to give. Your involvement helps make our Club a welcome community for all skaters.
